It's very particular to her situation, but I was very impressed by my 32-year-old daughter's problemsolving skills. She's been working part-time at Goodwill for over a year and remembered that around holiday time last year, candy was given out to all employees. Her Dad/workplace assistance said, "You could just refuse it," but April said if it was being distributed, she'd "have to" take it. Her solution: Find out precisely when this will happen and adjust her work hours that day so she isn't there at that time, so the problem doesn't arise. She's a good worker, so her supervisor is happy to make this kind of adjustment for particular circumstances.
