A Special Note for Families and Caregivers Bringing a Loved One Living with PWS

We are thrilled to welcome you and your loved ones to the 2025 International PWS Conference! We know that many individuals living with Prader-Willi syndrome will be attending sessions alongside their families, especially as camp spaces filled quickly. To help ensure a safe and supportive experience for all, we ask that caregivers remain with their loved ones at all times throughout the conference. Individuals with PWS should not be left unsupervised in any area of the resort or conference center.

Snack tables will be available for program attendees in the back of the Main Ballroom and in the Plaza (near the Serenity Room - Sierra 3) during scheduled times each day. While we aim to create a comfortable environment for all guests, these snack areas may include unattended food, which can present challenges for individuals living with PWS. Please plan accordingly and help us maintain a safe and respectful shared space. We also ask that any food waste be discarded in trash bins and not left unattended.

If your loved one needs a break during a session, feel free to quietly step outside and rejoin when ready. Our family sessions are designed to be welcoming and flexible for families.

Important: Family Program Lunch Details

To help us provide a smooth and organized lunch experience during the 2025 International PWS Conference, please review the following information carefully:

- All individuals registered for the Family Program will receive lunch and snacks on both Friday, June 27, and Saturday, June 28. No additional purchased lunch is required simply attend the Family Program sessions and enjoy!
- If you purchased the "Family Program Additional Lunch Option" for a loved one who is not registered for the Family Program, you will receive two lunch tickets for them at conference check-in. These tickets are valid for lunch on Friday and Saturday and must be presented to a volunteer at the buffet to receive a meal.
- If you are bringing a loved one to the Family Program who is not registered and you did
 not purchase the additional lunch option, they will not be able to receive the conferenceprovided lunch. Please plan to pack and bring lunch for them to eat.

Printing Not Available On-Site

Please note that we will not provide printed copies of agendas or other conference materials on site. We strongly encourage attendees to help us reduce the environmental impact of the conference by using the conference mobile app instead of printed documents.

The mobile app will have all the information you need, including session times, locations, and speaker details. You can even create a personalized schedule within the app to stay organized throughout the event. For added convenience, daily session schedules will also be posted outside each meeting room.

If you do choose to print any needed documents, including agendas, please do so at home before you travel.

Conference Mobile App

We created an app for the 2025 International PWS Conference! Our conference attendees are encouraged to use this app throughout the week to stay up to date with the latest news and announcements, see your personal schedule and add sessions to your agenda, and create your event profile.

Here are a few helpful tips and tricks to navigate the conference app:

- **Event Homepage:** Find helpful links, sponsor information, resort amenities, nearby grocery stores and urgent care centers, resort and conference center floor plans, and more!
- Event Schedule: Select the "Sessions" tab either in the main menu, homepage quick link, or the calendar () icon at the bottom of the screen. Next, click the plus () button next to a session to add it to your personal agenda. Click into each session to find out the speaker(s) and session description.
- Event Community: There are several ways to interact with fellow conference attendees using the mobile app. Click on the "attendees" button in the main menu to see a list of all conference attendees and send direct messages. We also encourage everyone to participate in our conference discussions! Select "Discussions" in the main menu to share posts in our discussion groups. These discussion groups are visible to all attendees.
- Event Profile: Here is where you can find conference announcements, view messages from other attendees, take surveys assigned to you, and update your personal profile. You can also choose to make your profile private so it is not visible to others in the app.

Please note: To view your event profile, you must log in to the app first. You will need to provide your first name, last name, and the email you used to register for the conference. You will then receive a verification code (via your phone and/or email) to input. Once you are logged in to the app, you can manage your profile. We also encourage everyone to stay logged into the app throughout the duration of the conference. If you log out, you will need to log back in with a new verification code each time.

How to Download:

 Step 1: Go to the Apple App Store or Google Play Store on your mobile device and search for "Cvent Events," or scan the QR code below with your phone camera to download the application. Once it has downloaded, select "Open."



- **Step 2:** When the Cvent Events app is open on your mobile device, type "United in Hope" in the search bar, and our *2025 United in Hope PWS Conference* event title will populate on the screen. Select that text to open the app.
- **Step 3:** Explore the United in Hope PWS Conference app! It offers the opportunity to add conference sessions to your personal agenda, interact with other attendees, get to know our sponsors and exhibitors, and so much more.

<u>Conference Check-In - Program Attendees</u>

Conference check-in is required before attending sessions.

All attendees must check in upon arrival before attending any sessions at the 2025 International PWS Conference. During check-in, program attendees will receive their official conference badge (required for entry into all sessions) and a welcome bag. Our team of volunteers will also be available at the check-in desk to help answer any questions and ensure a smooth start to the conference experience.

Where can I check in for the conference when I arrive at the Arizona Grand Resort & Spa?

The check-in desk will be located on the first floor of the resort's Conference Center (labeled "Ballroom Foyer" on the Conference Center resort map below). Is walk-up registration available?

Walk-up registration will not be available. Those attending must have already registered for the 2025 International PWS Conference before our registration deadline date - Tuesday, June 17, 2025.

How do I get to the conference space/check-in desk from the resort lobby?

Check out the map below to see the recommended route to take from the lobby to the conference center. Go out the back lobby patio doors toward the pond fountains. There, you will see ground directional stickers that will take you to the conference center. Alternatively, you can ask the lobby front desk to arrange a golf cart ride from the lobby to your room or the conference center.




How do I get to the conference space/check-in desk from the Camelback Suite building?

Check out the map below to see three routes you can take from the Camelback Suite building to the Conference Center. The easiest way will be to find the exit out of the building closest to the Oasis Waterpark and follow the ground directional signs. However, there is a walkway on the 3rd floor that will take you directly to the conference space. Once in the conference space, you will need to take the elevator or stairs down to the first floor to find the conference check-in desk.



How do I get to the conference space/check-in desk from the Sedona Suite building?

Check out the map below to see three routes you can take from the Sedona Suite building to the Conference Center. The easiest way will be to find the exit out of the building closest to the Oasis Waterpark and follow the ground directional signs. However, there is a walkway on the 4th floor that will take you directly to the conference space. Once in the conference space, you will need to take the elevator or stairs down to the first floor to find the registration desk.



How do I get to the conference check-in area from the conference center entrance?

If you are staying off the Arizona Grand Resort & Spa property, you will most likely drive to or be dropped off at the entrance of the resort's Conference Center. Enter through the Grand Veranda and you will find yourself on the first floor of the Conference Center. You will see the conference check-in area when you arrive.

Time Zone: Mountain Time (MT)

Climate: June temperatures are typically 100°F (38°C) or above during the day, and the air is very dry. In June, the typical nighttime temperature is around 76°F (24°C). This can vary slightly depending on the specific location, with some areas experiencing slightly cooler or warmer nights.

What to Wear in Phoenix in June

Phoenix in June means plenty of sunshine and daytime temps that often climb above 100°F (38°C). While all conference sessions will be held indoors with air conditioning, you'll need to walk outdoors between hotel rooms and the conference center, so it's important to dress smart!

Conference Attire Tips

There's no formal dress code for the conference, but here are some ideas to help you stay comfortable and prepared:

Keep Cool Outside

- · Lightweight, breathable fabrics like linen, cotton, or moisture-wicking materials
- Short-sleeved tops, flowy blouses, polos, or summer dresses
- Light-colored clothing that reflects (rather than absorbs) the sun
- Comfortable shoes or sandals for walking outdoors
- Please note: We will be walking outside to get to the lunch area each day

Stay Warm Inside

- Conference rooms can be chilly bring a light sweater, cardigan, or zip-up jacket

<u>Before You Travel (For International Attendees)</u>

Traveling to the U.S. is exciting, but good preparation is key. This checklist covers essential steps - from documents to cultural tips - to help ensure a smooth and stress-free trip.

Documents

- Valid passport (with at least 6 months validity remaining)
- Appropriate U.S. visa (B1/B2, F1, ESTA, etc.)
- Printed copy of visa approval/ESTA confirmation
- Return or onward ticket (often required for entry)
- Travel insurance (strongly recommended, especially for healthcare)

Health

- Proof of vaccinations (COVID-19, etc., if required)
- Prescriptions with doctor's note (especially for controlled medications)
- · Travel-size first aid kit and basic medications
- · Know where nearby clinics or urgent care centers are located at your destination

Packing Essentials

- · Clothing appropriate for the season and destination
- · Comfortable walking shoes
- Layers (AC indoors can be cold even in summer)

Tech and Connectivity

- Universal power adapter (U.S. uses Type A/B plugs, 110V)
- Unlocked phone for local SIM card (or international roaming plan)
- Download maps and key apps (Google Maps, Uber/Lyft, Google Translate)

Money and Finances

Currently, PHX Airport does not offer currency exchange services. We recommend exchanging currency before arriving in Arizona.

- Notify your bank of international travel to avoid card blocks
- Carry a mix of cash and cards (most places accept credit/debit cards)
- Small bills for tipping (restaurants, taxis, hotel staff)
- Currency exchange if not using cards

Upon Arrival

Airport and Customs

Most international arrivals land at Terminal 4, Level 3 (near Dunkin' Donuts) and pass through customs at this location.

- Know the address of your first stay (for customs declaration)
- Be prepared to explain your trip purpose and show proof of funds/accommodation
- Do not bring restricted items (fruits, meats, plants, large sums of cash)

Transportation

- Download rideshare apps (Uber/Lyft)
- · Research public transit passes if staying in large cities
- Have GPS or printed directions if renting a car

Cultural Tips

- Understand tipping etiquette (15–20% in restaurants, \$1-2 for services)
- Don't be afraid to ask questions conference organizers are here to help!

- · Save hotel and local contact numbers
